
















































## 20. What do you feel keeps people coming to Emmanuel?

A total of 95 comments were given to this question out of the 187 people that participated. The comments were placed into 6 categories: 1) teaching/preaching 2) music 3) community 4) youth/children ministry 5) outreach/missions and 6) other. The category having the most responses is teaching/preaching. The second highest comments were related to community. And the third highest category with comments was music.

## 21. Where do you envision our church in 5-7 years?

A total of 72 comments were given to this question out of the 187 people that participated. The comments were placed into 6 categories: 1) growth in Membership/community 2) growth in outreach 3) growth in youth/young families 4) an increase to volunteer base 5) staffing and 6) other. The category receiving the most comments were related to a vision of growth in membership and community. The category receiving the second most comments was related to a vision for increase of outreach. And the third category was for a vision of growing the youth ministry and young families within Emmanuel.

22. What do you hope will be different/expanded/changed at Emmanuel?

A total of 85 comments were given to this question out of the 187 people that participated. The comments were placed into 7 categories: 1) youth 2) outreach 3) staff enhancement 4) structure of service 5) relationships 6) focus of pastor 7) satisfied. The category receiving the most comments was related to expanding the youth. The category receiving the second most comments was building relationships in many forms. The third category had comments related to service structure.

23. What do you believe our congregation is looking for in our next Lead Pastor?

A total of 77 comments were received from the 187 people that participated. The comments were placed into 6 categories: 1) teacher 2) shepherd 3) relatable 4) good listener 5) servant 6) counselor. The most comments were received regarding teaching abilities. The second category was for the next Lead Pastor to be relatable. And the third category receiving comments was the ability to shepherd a congregation.

24. What kind of emphasis in theology do you think our next Lead Pastor should have?

A total of 71 responses were received from the 187 people participating in the survey. The responses were divided into 6 categories: 1) grace based 2) Calvinism 3) biblical based 4) apologetics 5) preterist view 6) reformed theology. The category receiving the most comments wanted a pastor with a biblical based theology. The second most comment wanted the next Lead Pastor to be rooted in grace. And the third most mentioned comment related to a reformed theology for the church.

25. What else would you like to be considered as we prayerfully search for a next Lead Pastor?

A total of 63 comments were made from the 187 people responding to the survey. The most frequent comment provided was one relating to the committee having patience in this process.

26. Is there anything else you would like us to know?

A total of 54 comments were made from the 187 responding to the survey. While this question could have been broken into categories, the clear message from the congregation was one of prayer for our committee, the church and the next Lead Pastor of Emmanuel Enid.
