PERSONAL TESTIMONY

I grew up in a very religious home, but I did not grow up with a relationship with Christ. My mother and father took me to church on a weekly basis. In addition to Sunday mornings, we often attended on Wednesday nights, and I went with friends on Sunday nights too. I learned all the songs, memorized many verses, knew when to stand up, sit down, kneel, and I knew most of the other religious rituals that were a part of my church experience growing up. However, participating in all the religious activity still left me feeling empty inside.

The emptiness led me down a path of searching how to fill the void in my life. Playing sports was my solace. I won many awards along the way. However, the trophies would eventually end up collecting dust, and the emptiness in my life would only grow stronger. After high school, I enlisted in the Navy believing a change in my surroundings might make a difference. I soon realized that a change in geography did not help fill the void. The emptiness in my life continued to grow, until I finally understood the Gospel.

On October 29, 1992, on a US Naval warship in the middle of the Pacific Ocean returning from the Persian Gulf, for the first time in my life I discovered it was not about religion, it was about a relationship with God through faith in Jesus Christ. It finally made sense to me, and I fully surrendered my life to Jesus Christ. After receiving Christ, I entered civilian life and then married my wife on May 22, 1993. God has blessed my wife and me with two incredible daughters, a son-in-law, and a granddaughter. I have devoted my life to serving the Lord in pastoral ministry since May of 1994. God has allowed me to preach in thousands of churches on six of the seven continents, in almost forty countries, and in most of the states in the U.S. I have learned a lot about the local church from experience, the classroom, books, and my extensive travels. God has been better to me than I deserve. However, the greatest thing God has done in my life is that He has given me the assurance that when I die, I will be with Him in a real place called Heaven for all of eternity because of my faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

This I believe - Pastor Shonn Keels

About God - There is only One true God (Dt. 6:4). God is a spirit; yet He is a personal being. He is the Creator of all things. He is omnipotent, omnipresent, and immutable. There is none like Him. He is the sovereign Ruler over all of creation. God is the Preserver of mankind and the Redeemer of all who will come to Him by faith in the Lord Jesus Christ. He is holy and righteous. He is the triune God who reveals Himself as three distinct Persons: The Father, The Son, and The Holy Spirit. In Him, there is no division.

About the Father - The Father is God. He is the first Person of the Godhead - Trinity (Mt. 28:19). He rules over His creation with perfect providential care. His wisdom and love have no limits. He is the Author, Sustainer, and Completer of salvation, and He desires that all come to repentance (2 Pet. 3:9).

About Jesus - The Son is God. He is the second Person of the Godhead - Trinity (Mt. 28:19). He is eternal and one with the Father and the Holy Spirit (Jn. 1:1-3). He is co-Creator (Col. 1:15-17). However, He did not allow His equality with God to keep Him from His primary mission of saving mankind from sin (Ph. 3:5-11). Jesus, who is the Son of God, in His incarnation, was conceived by God the Holy Spirit and born of a virgin named Mary (Lk. 1:26-38). Jesus completely and perfectly lived the will of God without sin and became sin on behalf of man (Heb. 4:15; 2 Cor. 5:21). Jesus died on the cross for sin, was buried, and was raised from the dead (1 Cor. 15:2-6). He ascended into heaven and now sits at the right hand of God as the only Mediator between God and man (1 Tim. 2:5). He will return to earth to judge all people and to complete the plan of redemption (Mt. 24; 2 Cor. 5:10; 1 Cor. 3:10-15; Rev. 20:11-15).

About the Holy Spirit - The Holy Spirit is God (Acts 5:1-5). He is the third Person of the Godhead - Trinity (Mt. 28:19). He is eternal and one with the Father and the Son. He exalts Jesus as Christ. He enables men to understand truth (Jn. 14:26), and He inspired men to write God's Word (2 Pet. 1:20-21). He convicts men of sin, of righteousness, and of judgment (Jn. 16:9-11). He draws men to Christ for salvation. He empowers the believer to live a holy life (Gal. 5:16-26). He is the Comforter and the Giver of all spiritual gifts (Jn. 14:16; 1 Cor. 12:1-11). He is the abiding presence of Jesus and dwells within the believer guaranteeing salvation (Eph. 1:13-15). He is the power inside the life and witness of every believer (Acts 1:8).

About Scriptures - The Scriptures are God's infallible and inerrant Word written by divinely inspired men. God is the author and redemption is its end. His Word is complete, without error in its message, and chock-full of divine wisdom and instruction for man. The Scriptures are the final authority on all matters relating to faith and life. The Gospel is its preeminent message.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

About Human Beings – Humans are divinely created in the image of God. God created humans to be male and female. Man was created perfectly yet by his free will man sinned and through his rebellion sin entered the world. Adam's sin has been passed to all and all are born sinners (Rom. 3:23). Man in his sinful state is destined to a real place called hell unless he responds positively to the grace of God that is extended to all through faith in the Lord Jesus Christ.

About Salvation – Salvation is deliverance from the power and punishment of sin (Rom. 6:23). Salvation is possible for all who believe in Jesus (Rom. 10:9-10). God is the Author and Completer of salvation (Jn. 3:16-17). In short, God loves man, man sinned, God gives Jesus, man must repent (turn from) his sin and believe in the Lord Jesus to receive salvation.

About Eternal Security – Eternal life is eternal which means it does not end. Those who believe in Jesus and receive eternal life are eternally secure (Rom. 8:38-39, Eph. 1:13).

About Eternity – Eternity had no beginning, and it has no end. Sometime in the future God, according to His timetable, will bring time as we understand it to an end. Jesus will return to the earth personally and visibly according to the promise of God in the Scriptures to judge both the righteous and the unrighteous. The righteous will be saved, and the unrighteous will perish.

About Baptism by Immersion – Baptism represents the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. Baptism follows salvation. The word baptism means to immerse and the testimony in Scripture points to immersion (Acts 8:30-38; Rom. 6:3-4; Mt. 28:18-20).

About the Lord's Supper - The Lord's Supper is a lasting ordinance given to the church by the Lord Jesus. The bread and the cup represent the broken body and blood of Jesus. The Church is to celebrate communion regularly proclaiming His death until He returns (1 Cor. 11:23-26).

About Evangelism - Evangelism is the privilege and responsibility of all believers (Mt. 28:18-20). All believers are responsible for evangelizing their neighbors and the nations (Acts 1:8).

About the Church - The Church is the universal body of Christ made up of baptized believers. The Church is made up of local churches all over the world. The local church is an autonomous congregation of baptized believers. The local church is governed by God's laws under the Lordship of Christ through the leadership of the local congregation.

About Christian Unity – The two greatest laws in all of Scripture are to love God and to love one another (Mt. 22:34-40). Christian unity is a high priority (Mt. 5:23-24). We are better together!

BY LAWS VOTING INFORMATION

Voting Information from By-Laws

Article 1, Section 2

Membership at Emmanuel Enid includes the right to vote at all elections and on all questions submitted to the church in any regularly scheduled or called business meeting. Only church members are eligible to be elected to church offices, committees, or boards.

Voting Information from By - Laws

Article 3, Section 2, Paragraph 4

The Pastor Search Committee will present to Emmanuel Enid the individual they recommend to fill the Lead Pastor position at Emmanuel Enid. The Lead Pastor candidate will preach in view of a call at the Sunday morning worship services, and church approval of the Pastor Search Committee's recommendation will be by secret ballot. The candidate will be considered called by Emmanuel Enid as Lead Pastor upon receiving an 80% affirmative vote of members present at a special called business meeting.

Vote to Call Lead Pastor

The special called business meeting will be open from 7:30am until 1pm and again 5pm-6pm on Sunday, November 14th, for the purpose of obtaining a ballot and voting for the call of Lead Pastor; no other church business will be discussed or voted on during this time. All ballots must be returned by 6pm on November 14th. For those church members that are homebound or not comfortable in attending a large gathering, you may contact the church office (580-242-0602) to have the Deacon Service Committee deliver a brochure and/or ballot. All ballots in this case must be picked up and returned to the church prior to the close of voting.
